## Background:

At its sixth meeting, the Conference of the Parties adopted the process to enable it to evaluate at its seventh meeting the continued need for perfluorooctane sulfonic acid (PFOS), its salts and perfluorooctane sulfonyl fluoride (PFOSF) for the various acceptable purposes and specific exemptions listed in Annex B to the Convention, in accordance with paragraphs 5 and 6 of part III of that Annex.

  - o The progress made to eliminate PFOS, its salts and PFOSF, in the process of reporting under Article 15 of the Convention, in accordance with paragraph 3 of part III of Annex B to the Convention; (request a)
  - o The production and use of PFOS, its salts and PFOSF, in the process of reporting under Article 15 of the Convention, as specified in paragraph 5(b) of part III of Annex B to the Convention; (request b)
  - o The availability, suitability and implementation of alternatives to PFOS, its salts and PFOSF, as specified in paragraph 5(c) of part III of Annex B to the Convention; (request c)
  - The progress made in building the capacity of countries to transfer safely to reliance on alternatives to PFOS, its salts and PFOSF; as specified in paragraph 5(d) of part III of Annex B to the Convention. (request d)
