The eighth meeting of the Persistent Organic Pollutants Review Committee of the Stockholm Convention took place from 15 to 19 October 2012, in Geneva. The report of the meeting (UNEP/POPS/POPRC.8/16) is available on the Convention's website: http://www.pops.int/poprc/.
